Warm weather caused melting and manure run off. Went into ditch. So far they pumped 75000g of manure and ice melt out of ditch. Ditch runs into pond and into another ditch. Still working on clean up.

DEC Investigator Remarks:

03/08/14: CH TELECON W/ RYAN AIKEN OF HEMDALE FARMS. ON 3/7/14, THE FARM STARTED SPREADING MANURE IN THE MORNING ON A 40 ACRE FIELD. THE AVOIDED AREAS OF KNOWN RUNOFF AND WERE CONSERVATIVE ON THE SET BACKS FROM DITCHES AND RUNOFF AREAS BECAUSE THEY HAD CONCERN OF RUNOFF FROM WARMING TEMPS SINCE THE GROUND IS FROZEN AND SNOW MELT WOULD RUNOFF RATHER THAN SOAK INTO THE GROUND. IN THE AFTERNOON THEY NOTICED THAT SNOW MELT FROM WARMING TEMPS WAS CAUSING RUNOFF OF THE MANURE. IT WAS PRIMARILY OCCURRING IN TWO LOCATIONS ON THE FIELD. THE RUNOFF WAS GOING TO A DITCH. SPREADING WAS DISCONTINUED AND AN ALL OUT EFFORT TO CONTAIN AND RECOVER THE MANURE WAS INITIATED. THE FARM HAD 8 PEOPLE WORKING UNTIL ALMOST MIDNIGHT TO CONTAIN AND RECOVER MANURE FROM THE DITCH. THEY HAD APPLIED APPROX 300,000 GALLONS TO THE FIELD. THEY DID NOT SPREAD WITHIN A 100 FT OF RUNOFF AREAS. FROM WHAT THEY RECOVERED LAST NIGHT, AIKEN ESTIMATES 50,000 – 75,000 GALLONS MADE IT TO THE DITCH, OF WHICH THEY RECOVERED MOST OF IT. THEY HAD A VAC TANKER AND PUMPS AT THE DITCH RECOVERING THE MATERIAL AND TRANSPORTING IT BACK TO THEIR LAGOON. THE PUMPING EQUIPMENT IS STILL IN

PLACE. CURRENTLY THERE IS NO MANURE IN THE DITCH OTHER THAN A LITTLE RESIDUAL THAT MAY HAVE TO BE EXCAVATED OUT. THERE IS SOME MATERIAL PONDED BEHIND CONTAINMENT PLACED NEAR THE DITCH. THEY ARE CURRENTLY WAITING FOR A TRUCK LOAD OF ABSORBENT MATERIAL TO SOAK UP THE PONDED MATERIAL. THE ABSORBENT MATERIAL IS WHAT THEY USE FOR BEDDING. IT IS A RECYCLED CARDBOARD PRODUCT. AIKEN STATES THAT BEFORE THEY COULD GET THE MANURE CONTAINED **SOME DID FLOW DOWN THE DITCH AND OVER THE ICE ON A NEIGHBORS POND AND THEN BACK INTO A DITCH.** WHERE THEY CONTAINED IT AT A SLUCE PIPE. THE POND IS APPROX 75 FT WIDE BY 150-175 FT LONG AND IT DOES NOT APPEAR THAT ANY OF THE MANURE WENT INTO THE POND, JUST FLOWED OVER THE ICE ON THE POND. THE LAST CONTAINED AREA IS ACROSS THE ROAD FROM 2042 BUFFALO ROAD. AIKEN STATES THEY CHECKED THE DITCH FURTHER DOWN STREAM ALL THE WAY TO FLINT CREEK WHERE THE DITCH EVENTUALLY EMPTIES AND THEY SEE NO EVIDENCE OF THE MANURE. CH ASK IF THEY TRIED TO INCORPORATE THE MANURE INTO THE FIELD ON FRIDAY. AIKEN STATES THEY MADE SEVERAL PASSES WITH A DISK, BUT GROUND WAS SO FROZEN IT DID NO GOOD. AIKEN STATES THEY WILL CONTINUE TO MONITOR OVER THE WEEKEND AND WILL PUMP OR ABSORB ANY MATERIAL THAT COMES NEAR THE DITCH. AIKENS SAFETY OFFICER CASEY CAN ALSO BE CONTACTED IF AIKEN IS NOT AVAILABLE. CH NOTIFIES PM, NANCY RICE AND ECO'S LUTZ AND BLANTON. LUTZ HAD BEEN NOTIFIED BY DISPATCH AND CALLED TO SEE IF SPILLS WAS GOING TO RESPOND. CH STATES SINCE SITUATION WAS CONTAINED AND CLEANUP HAD ALREADY OCCURED, CH WOULD INSPECT MONDAY UNLESS SITUATION CHANGED.

03/10/14: CH MEETS AT THE FARM WITH RYAN AIKEN & CASEY KUNES OF HEMDALE AND THEIR CAFO CONSULTANT, JIM. WE GO TO THE FIELD WHERE RUNOFF OCCURED AND RYAN SHOWS ME WHERE THE TWO MAIN RUNOFF LOCATIONS WERE AND HOW THEY TRIED TO IMPEDE THE FLOW. HE SHOWS ME WHERE HE EXCAVATED A SMALL COLLECTION SUMP WITH A BACK HOE TO CAPTURE AND PUMP THE RUNOFF FROM. THAT IS CURRENTLY EMPTY. THE IMPACTED POND IS IMMEDIATELY ADJACENT(WEST) TO THE FIELD. THERE ARE SOME SOLIDS OVER AN APPROX 30FT X 30 FT AREA ON THE SE CORNER OF THE POND. THE FARM IS GOING TO TRY AND SCRAPE THE SOLIDS OFF. THEY HAVE STRAW ROUND BALES IN THE DITCH LINE AND AT THE AREAS IN THE FIELD WHERE THE PRIMARY RUNOFF WAS OCCURING. THEY ALSO BROUGHT IN AN ABSORBENT MATERIAL, WHICH THEY USE FOR BEDDING IN THE BARN, TO TRY AND ABSORB SOME OF THE POOLED MATERIAL. THE FARMS CONCERN IS REGARDING FUTURE RUNOFF. A LARGE SNOW STORM IS PREDICTED FOR LATER IN THE WEEK FOLLOWED BY A WARM TREND. THE FARM IS CONCERNED RUNOFF WILL OCCUR AGAIN. THEY FEAR IF THEY LEAVE DITCHES PLUGGED WATER WILL BACK UP AND RUN OFF IN AREAS THEY CAN'T CONTROL. CH RECOMMENDS REMOVING ABSORBENTS AND STRAW IN DITCHES NOW AND THEN PUTTING OUT FEWER BALES IN STRATEGIC LOCATIONS TO TRY AND FILTER OUT SOLIDS AND STILL NOT BACK UP THE FLOWS. THE RUNOFF WATER IN THE DITCH DOWNSTREAM FROM FIELD LOOKS CLEAR. OVERALL EFFORTS SEEM ADEQUATE. CH WILL MONITOR WHEN THAWING OCCURS. NANCY RICE NOTIFIED. SOME PICTURES TAKEN.

03/14/14: CH INSPECTS THE DITCH CROSSING JUST SOUTH OF HEMDALE FARMS. THE WATER DOES HAVE SOME BROWNISH DISCOLORATION, BUT THERE ARE NO NOTICEABLE SOLIDS OR ODOR TO THE WATER. CH TRIES TO INSPECT THE DITCH CLOSER TO THE DISCHARGE POINT, BUT THEY ARE ALL FILLED WITH SNOW. THE FIELD IS STILL SNOW COVERED.

06/8/15: REVIEW OF FILE. SPILL SHOULD BE CLOSED. CLEANUP HAD BEEN DONE TO THE EXTENT POSSIBLE. **SOME MATERIAL DID RUNOFF TO STREAM.** ONCE SNOW WAS GONE AND GROUND THAWED, REMAINING MATERIAL WAS INCORPORATED INTO THE SOIL BY PLOWING. SPILL SHOULD HAVE BEEN CLOSED IN SPRING OF 2014.

04/28/2017: THALL TELECON WITH CLINTON ZIMMERMAN AT 22:30. A C-CLAMP FAILED ON A 10 PIPE/HOSE, RESULTING IN THE RELEASE OF APPROXIMATELY 15,000 GALLONS OF LIQUID MANURE TO A TRIBUTARY OF BROWNS CREEK. A SOIL BERM HAS BEEN CONSTRUCTED APPROXIMATELY 300 YDS DOWNSTREAM. THERE IS A MODERATE FLOW IN THE DITCH. THE CONCENTRATED MANURE IS BEING PUMPED BACK INTO THE LAGOON AND ALSO PUMPED INTO SPREADER TANKERS.

04/29/2017: THALL TELECON WITH CLINTON ZIMMERMAN AT 06:10. APPROXIMATELY 45,000 GALLONS OF MANURE/WATER MIXTURE HAS BEEN PUMPED/RECOVERED FROM THE DITCH SO FAR. IN ADDITION TO PUMPING AT THE SOURCE, A PUMPING OPERATION WAS SET UP AT 02:00 AT THE EAST YORK ROAD UNDERPASS. MODERATE TO HEAVY TURBIDITY AND FOAM IS STILL EVIDENT IN A FEW PLACES DOWNSTREAM.

04/29/2017: THALL TELECON WITH ECO CHRIS WARD AND KEVIN NIEDERMIER (LIVINGSTON COUNTY EMERGENCY MANAGER) AT 06:30. THE

CONDITIONS AS REPORTED BY ZIMMERMAN ARE CONFIRMED. IT IS DECIDED TO BEGIN FLUSHING WITH FRESH WATER FROM A NEARBY POND.

04/29/2017: THALL ON SITE AT 09:00 WITH:

CLINTON ZIMMERMAN (RESPONSIBLE PARTY/SPRING LAKE FARMS: 315-729-1066) AMOS SMITH (LAWNEL FARMS: 585-233-8813) GERALD DENNING (TOWN OF YOUR SUPERVISOR: 585-204-7002)

GEORGE WORDEN (TOWN OF YORK HIGHWAY SUPERINTENDENT: 585-329-7757) JIM BOOTH (WNY CROP MANAGEMENT: 585-991-3153) JIM PECANO (LIVINGSTON COUNTY DOH: 585-943-0943).

SPRING LAKE FARMS WAS HIRED BY LAWNEL FARMS TO PUMP AND SPREAD THE LIQUID MANURE ON VARIOUS FIELDS OWNED BY LAWNEL FARMS. THE MANURE/LAGOON IS OWNED BY LAWNEL FARMS. THE DITCH ADJACENT TO THE LAGOON FLOWS EAST AND ENTERS BROWNS CREEK IN THE VILLAGE OF YORK. THE CREEK FLOWS BEHIND A RESIDENTIAL AREA BETWEEN CHESTNUT STREET AND EAST YORK ROAD AND CONTINUES EAST AND ENTERS THE GENESEE RIVER APPROXIMATELY 3 MILES FROM THE VILLAGE. THE CREEK IS VERY TURBID AND A STRONG MANURE ODOR IS EVIDENT AS IT FLOWS THROUGH THE VILLAGE. PUMPS AND TANK TRUCKS WERE USED TO RECOVER AS MUCH LIQUID AS POSSIBLE. SEVERAL RECOVERY POINTS WERE SET UP AND PUMPING CONTINUED THROUGHOUT THE NIGHT. CLEAR WATER (FROM A POND OWNED BY LAWNEL FARMS LOCATED ~2600' SW OF THE SPILL) IS BEING INTRODUCED TO THE DITCH ADJACENT TO THE LAGOON/MANURE RELEASE LOCATION. AS OF 10:30, APPROXIMATELY 75,000 GALLONS OF FRESH WATER HAS BEEN INTRODUCED. THE TURBIDITY IN BROWN'S CREEK CONTINUES TO DISSIPATE. AS OF 14:15 APPROXIMATELY 175,000 GALLONS OF FRESH WATER HAS BEEN INTRODUCED. FLUSHING WILL CONTINUE THROUGHOUT THE DAY. AMOS SMITH AND CLINTON ZIMMERMAN ESTIMATE THAT APPROXIMATELY 80,000 GALLONS OF MANURE/WATER MIXTURE WAS PUMPED FROM THE DITCH/CREEK DURING THE RECOVERY EFFORT.

05/01/2017: THALL AND NANCY RICE (DOW) MEET WITH AMOS SMITH ON SITE AT 10:45. THE TURBIDITY/FOAMING IN THE DITCH AND IN BROWNS CREEK HAS RETURNED TO NORMAL CONDITIONS. RICE WILL HANDLE ANY FOLLOWUP ACTION BY THE DEPARTMENT. NO FURTHER ACTION IS ANTICIPATED BY THE REGION 8 SPILLS SECTION AT THIS TIME.

County: Chautauqua Municipality: Kennedy/Randolph Location Or Address: The creek running along Route 394 across from County Line Rd. How Did It Occur: From the slurry pit overflowing into the creek.

DEC Investigator Remarks:

10/10/17 ECO Jason Powers was on scene and identified dead fish from Beavers farm to Conewango Creek in a creek he identified as Dry Creek (more than a mile away). He said there were trout and many other types of fish, the odor was horrendous and the manure was thick and sludgy. He said Dale Beavers accepted responsibility for the release of manure. An ECO was to check on the creek over the weekend. The release from the manure pond stopped – there was no active release. Ted Myers and Brian Hourigan were

notified and would handle the cleanup next week with the farmer. Beavers farm have had historical problems and have violated previous consent orders for the same issues. No further action by spills is possible. Closed.

THOMAS SPOKE WITH THE OWNER’S OF THE FARM (PHIL BENNETT, FATHER AND JAY BENNETT, SON) AND JASON ROSS (EMPLOYEE). THEY SAID THAT THEY DISCOVERED THE SPILL AT 5 AM AND CLEAN-UP BEGAN AT 5:10 AM. Collision occurred just east of Tanner Creek crossing and discharge migrated along roadway to drainage swale leading to Tanner Creek (Class D waterbody). Vehicle owned by Gebarten Acres farm located west on same road.

Upon arrival at site, Gebarten Acres owner, Greg Coller, and his staff had placed hay bales along all liquid manure channeling paths adjacent to road and were actively placing and removing absorbent pads on the floating fuel. One 55 gallon bag was full of spent pads upon arrival. Hay bales located at multiple locations along drainage swale toward Tanner Creek. Rain forecasted, owner said to get our contractor mobilized while he called insurance company. Eggen Excavating mobilized at 13:30.

MWD and ECO Canary walked drainage ditch to Tanner Creek discharge. Ditch began as wide swampy area and developed into channel approx. 2' wide prior to discharge with a mix of marsh and fast flowing sections throughout reach. Visible rainbow sheen emanating into Tanner Creek. 8 boom placed across opening. Pockets of fuel/sheen and manure throughout reach – mild petroleum odor and strong manure odor. Small over/under dam constructed and absorbent pads placed throughout reach. Drainage swale and surrounding area enveloped in dense brush and 3–4 inch trees. Most accessible route to Tanner Creek discharge would be by boat.

Emergency utility callout placed. Contractor arrived at 16:50 and excavation began after utility representative cleared path. Created staging area for impacted soils on silage bunker at Gebarten Acres. Poly liner placed on asphalt to receive spoils. Excavation continued along roadway and into wide marshy area close to road where significant amount of petroleum had accumulated. Bermed drainage swale and placed boom and pads. Soil pile sampled and covered with poly. Excavated area leveled out and road swept. Will backfill and regrade when spoils are disposed.

Several of the neighbors' wells are within 100' of these open cesspools and stacks of manure while there are several more within

200'. There is a running stream that runs through this barnyard that changes color as it passes through due to the contamination runoff. They also stack manure adjacent to this stream, which have been carried downstream during heavy rain.

We can no longer use our back yards the way we used to due to the stench and increased mosquito and horsefly populations. Attached are a few pictures which barley begin to illustrate the problem. I have read the public health law 206(18), which was my premise for contacting DEC. Pictures are Date/Time stamped.

Please help us recover our town from this ecological catastrophe.

Thank you for your email. The NYS Environmental Conservation Law regulates concerns that adversely affects the environment, so I will be forwarding a spill report to the local DEC Spill on call personnel regarding the contamination of the stream. The other conditions that you describe and have provided photos of are not enforceable by DEC. NYS Public Health Laws, which are targeted for the protection of human health, are enforceable by state or county Health Dept or local Code Enforcement officials. Flow appeared at lower access point 3 hours after start of flushing. Recovery continued for several hours following.

No further action required. Referred to DOW (on site and in agreement with flushing plan during the day) for follow up and any compliance/enforcement issues associated with CAFO. Closed. BB

This bay is used for water for several cottages on that bay and it is upstream from the Clayton Water Plant. This creek drains an area west of the hamlet of St Lawrence Corners where a large dairy is located. This dairy has been dumping manure slurry on snow and/or frozen ground.
