06/27/11 0810 KEHOE TELECON WITH JEFF BOWERS AND ERIC SCHINSING, WELD ON PORTABLE TANK WAS BAD ALLOWING TANK TO LEAK. TANK WAS ON SITE FOR EXTRA CAPACITY WHILE A BRINE DISPOSAL LOCATION IS FOUND SINCE CURRENT LOCATION IS NOT ACCEPTING BRINE.

06/27/11 1500 KEHOE ON SITE TO MEET WITH TALISMAN REPS. BRINE SPILL WAS FROM ONE OF TWO MOBIL STORAGE TANKS WITH BAD WELD. TALISMAN HAS BEEN BRINGING BRINE FROM OTHER WELLS ON SITE FOR STORAGE. BRINE SPILL WAS ON WEST SIDE OF PAD AND FLOWED EAST AND SOUTHEAST OFF THE PAD INTO A DIVERSION CHANNEL AND OFF SITE TO THE SOUTH INTO A FARM FIELD. IMPACTS WERE NOT YET EXTENSIVE OFF SITE BUT DEAD VEGETATION WAS OBVIOUS. TALISMAN HAS A PLAN TO SAMPLE FOR BRINE ACROSS PAD AND OFF SITE THEN EXCAVATE THE WORST

AREAS. SMALL CATCH BASINS WILL BE ADDED TO THE DIVERSION CHANNEL TO CATCH RUNOFF, WATER WILL BE PUMPED BACK TO THE BRINE TANKS.

07/05/11 1545 KEHOE TELECON WITH ERIC SCHINSING, PRODUCTION TANK MAY ALSO HAVE A LEAK, PUTTING TOGETHOR A PLAN TO TEST OR CHANGE OUT THAT TANK. PLAN WILL TAKE A DAY OR SO. SUMPS ARE IN PLACE BUT NO BRINE HAS SHOWN UP, MORE SOIL WILL MOST LIKELY BE REMOVED.

07/13/11 0900 KEHOE ON SITE WITH JOE YAROSZ AND ERIC SCHINSING, NOTHING NEW TO REPORT. THREE SUMPS HAVE BEEN INSTALLED, ONE HAD SALT CRYSTALS AND ONE HAD WATER IN BOTTOM (MAY BE BRINE). PLAN TO REGRADE AREA OUTSIDE OF FENCE, EXCAVATE MORE SOIL FROM THE PAD AND INSTALL PUMPS TO PUMP ANY COLLECTED SUMP WATER TO BRINE TANKS.

CALLER REPORTS THE VALVE ON THE BRINE TANK FROZE AND BROKE. ALLOWING ABOUT 18 BARRELS OF BRINE TO LEAK OUT SINCE MARCH 3. REPAIRS TO BE MADE ASAP. COPY TO CK AND MINERALS.

DEC Investigator Remarks:

03/09/10 1100 KEHOE ON SITE TO OBSERVE REPORT, MET WITH JOE YAROSZ (DEC) AND JEFF BOWER (FORTUNA). MR. BOWER REPORTED THAT THE VALVE IN THE BRINE TANK DRAIN LINE HAD FROZE DAMAGING THE INNER SEALS. THE PIPE CAP WAS ALSO FOUND TO HAVE BEEN EITHER DAMAGED BY ICE OR POSSIBLY CROSS THREADED ALLOWING THE TANK TO LEAK. THE TANK WAS SUPPOSEDLY MEASURED ON MARCH 3, 2010 AND SINCE HAD LOST ABOUT 18 INCHES OF BRINE. THIS EQUATES TO ABOUT 18 BARRELS OF BRINE OR ABOUT 756 GALLONS. UPON FINDING THE LEAK FORTUNA HAD THE TANK DRAINED TO BELOW THE DRAIN LINE AND THE VALVE WAS REPLACED. THIS WELL IS SUPPOSEDLY A LOW VOLUME PRODUCER WITH BRINE WATER FAIRLY DILUTE AT 8.41 POUNDS PER GALLON WITH A SPECIFIC GRAVITY OF 1.01. A SIMILAR SPECIFIC GRAVITY OF 1.02 WAS 2,200 MG/L OF SALINITY. SEA WATER BY CONTRAST IS 3,500MG/L. FORTUNA AGREED TO DIG A COUPLE OF TEST PITS AND SAMPLE SOILS AND GROUND WATER TO DETERMINE IMPACTS. FIRST TESTS WILL BE DONE NEAR THE TANK; ADDITIONAL INVESTIGATION SAMPLING WILL BE DETERMINED ONCE THIS INFORMATION IS BACK. KEHOE CALCULATION OF QUANTITY OF SALT IN SOLUTION IS 13.88 POUNDS.

SEVERAL MONTHS AGO WHILE RESPONDING TO A SPILL, SPILL RESPONDER CARL HETTENBAUGH, NOTICED WHAT APPEARED TO BE SURFICIAL PETROLEUM STAINING ON THE GROUND SURFACE AT A GAS WELL SITE ON THE EAST SIDE OF RT 89 JUST NORTH OF MC CANN AND MONTANNA ROADS. HETTENBAUGH COULD NOT STOP AT THE TIME BECAUSE OF THE OTHER RESPONSE. CH FORGOT TO WRITE UP A SPILL AS THE SITE SLIPPED HIS MIND

DEC Investigator Remarks:

ON 10/25/10 WHEN DRIVING BY THE SITE AGAIN, CH NOTICED THE SPILL HAD NOT BEEN ADDRESSED. CH STOPPED AT THE SITE AND INSPECTED THE WELL LOCATION. THERE WAS EVIDENCE OF PETROLEUM CONTAMINATION SURROUNDING THE WELL HEAD. THE WATER AROUND THE WELL HEAD HAS A SHEEN AND THE GROUND IS STAINED WITH PETRO. THE PETROLEUM STAINING EXTENDS APPROXIMATELY 75-100 FT TO THE SOUTH EAST. THERE IS ALSO AN ISOLATED STAIN APPROXIMATELY 100 FT TO THE SOUTH WEST OF THE WELL HEAD. THE SIGN ON THE WELL LOCATION INDICATES THE OWNER OF THE WELL IS: ASPECT ENERGY, 9489 ALEXANDER RD, ALEXANDER, NY 14005. THE WELL NAME IS: EVERHART, B. 1H. THE API NUMBER IS: #31-117-26425-00. CH NOTIFIED LINDA COLLART OF MINERALS BY EMAIL OF THE SITE. COLLART ADVISED CH THE WELL HAD BEEN DRILLED USING MINERAL OIL. CH TO FORWARD INFORMATION TO BILL GLYNN OF MINERALS. COPY TO MINERALS. CLOSED.

IT APPEARS THAT **WOOD CHIPS WERE USED TO SOAK UP THE OIL BUT WAS NEVER CLEANED UP.** I WILL CONTACT COMPANY FOR REMEDIATION OF SITE. THE LEASE #1 483 HAS BEEN IN PLACE FOR < 1YEAR.

6/16/11 TDJ CONTACTED ENTERVEST AT (814) 589-7441 TO SET UP REMOVAL OF CONTAMINATED SOIL. REP. FROM ENTERVEST CALLED BACK AND WILL GET CONTRACTOR TO REMOVE AND DISPOSE OF SPILL AREA. WILL CONTACT ME WHEN WORK BEGINS.

MR. TORREY IS THE LANDOWNER AND WOULD LIKE THE DEPARTMENT TO RESPOND TO THE CRUDE OIL THAT IS SEEPING OUT OF THE SIDE OF THE BANK FROM THE DALLAS MORRIS LEASE ONTO HIS PROPERTY, SWAMP AREA BELOW THE LEASE. THE SPILL HAS BEEN REPORTED PREVIOUSLY AND DALLAS MORRIS RESPONDED BUT THE DISCHARGE STARTED HAPPENING AGAIN. MR. TORREY IS ALSO CONCERNED WITH THE APPARENT IRON DISCHARGE FROM THE SEEP AS WELL.
